I was born on November 28th (1968) in Chur and grew up in Maienfeld, where my parents managed Schloss Brandis for several years. In 1989, I completed my Matura in Schiers. After that, I studied sports at ETH Zurich for one semester, but due to my visual impairment, this field of study wasn't the most suitable for me. Therefore, I changed my major and began to study human medicine, completing three semesters. In April 1993, I moved to Bloomington, Minnesota, to study chiropractic. I completed my studies in December 1996 and returned to beautiful Switzerland. In 1997, I passed the first part of my state exam while working with Dr. Urs Rohner in St.
